This season we are looking for a fantastic new supervisor to produce lollies and help manage other elements of production such as ordering stock, processing orders and overseeing daily food hygiene/haccp processes. This role will play a vital role in meeting our ambitious sales targets - supporting our exciting plans to scale up in winter 2024!

Job Description

Our lolly supervisor will work closely with the board of directors to ensure that the day to day production in the kitchen runs smoothly - supporting us to drive up sales in our exciting fourth season of trading! In particular the post holder will be lead on and be responsible for:

- Producing lollies in our community kitchen @ Flo's
- Stock management - communicating with our suppliers and placing orders as needed
- Ensuring orders from vendors are produced and supplied in a timely manner
- Advising the board on kitchen needs/suggestions for improvement etc.
- Inducting/Supporting other lolly makers in the kitchen
- Overseeing all food hygiene processes and traceability systems
- Supporting finance team with financial admin (supplying receipts etc as appropriate)
- Occasional work selling lollies at events on our fab lolly bike
